Summit parents,

I want to invite you to hear a fantastic speaker on the topic of **anxiety in children and teens** on **Wednesday, Feb. 1, from 7-8:30 p.m. in Rockwood Summit's Theater.**

According to the National Institute of Mental Health, more than 25% of kids aged 13–18 have a diagnosable anxiety disorder at some point in their life. We certainly see the impact of anxiety on students in our elementary, middle, and high schools in Rockwood.

Amy Maus, MSW, LCSW, is the Assistant Director at West County Psychological Associates. She specializes in service to schools, providing training to school personnel and parents. On Feb. 1, Amy Maus will share information about anxiety in school-aged children and advice for families with a child experiencing anxiety with parents from Rockwood Summit and our feeder schools.

I heard Ms. Maus speak last year, and found the presentation to be very helpful as a parent. Ms. Maus has also shared her message with Rockwood Summit staff this fall. I'm very excited to have her back to speak with our parents.
