News From The Principal

Dear Rockwood Summit Families,

On April 4, Rockwood voters will consider Proposition T (Thrive) to address increasing enrollment and our continued support for STEM/Innovative learning. In this latest edition of [SuperTalks with our Rockwood Superintendent](#), Dr. Eric Knost provides an overview of Prop T. I encourage you to take a few moments to view the video and learn about the projects funded by the bond issue.

Rockwood consistently balances its budget and works hard to be fiscally responsible. In fact, we are one of only four school districts in Missouri to earn [a AAA rating from Standard & Poor's](#) for this high level of financial responsibility.

Prop T is a \$95.5 million bond issue that will not raise the current Rockwood tax rate. A four-sevenths (57.14 percent) majority is necessary for passage.

Prop T will fund innovative learning in our school. Walking through our classrooms, we see students are working on important skills like communication and collaboration. We see students working together to solve problems, anticipate needs and adapt to changes. Students are learning as they acquire knowledge in subject matter and become tech-savvy. The key is a shift from students gaining knowledge to students discovering how to apply what they have learned.

Our Rockwood Superintendent Dr. Eric Knost has recently shared a video that shows what innovation looks like throughout our school district. This video features some Rockwood Summit students involved in our biofuel project. [Please take a moment to view the video!](#)

Funds from Prop T will also expand the implementation of the one-to-one, student-to-technology program. Learn more about [Prop T on the April 4 ballot](#).
