



Rockwood R-VI School District 1:1 Program Agreement

The student and parent/guardian named below agree to assume full responsibility for the safety, care and maintenance of the Chromebook in accordance with the Rockwood R-VI School District 1:1 Program Handbook (the "Handbook"). As set forth in the Handbook, damaged or lost Chromebooks will be reviewed and when deemed appropriate a fee could be charged on a case-by-case basis. We are pleased our Chromebooks are purchased with four-year accidental damage coverage which should cover the majority of accidents that occur. The student agrees to abide by District policies and procedures, including but not limited to the District Technology Acceptable Use Policy (<http://bit.do/rsd-aup>) and the Handbook (<http://bit.do/rsd-1to1>), while using the Chromebook. The Chromebook is the property of the District and, as such, is subject to monitoring and search of its contents at any time. There is no expectation of privacy in use or data stored on the Chromebook. When a student ends enrollment in a Rockwood school, the device must be returned to the school or a charge will be assessed.
