Arrival Procedures

In Person

EHS WILL OPEN ITS DOORS AT 8:00 AM UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE.

At 8:00 am, students should enter the building through one of two entries:

- Main Welcome Center entrance
- Courtyard entrance for students with 1st/2nd period Gym, Orchestra, or Band

As students will not have academic lockers, they should report immediately to their 1st/2nd period class as soon as they enter the building. Students will not be allowed to congregate or linger in the hallways, locker bays, or foyers. Students who want to get breakfast will be able to stop by the cafeteria to pick-up their morning meals. Students need to make sure and get to their first class by the 8:28 am bell.

Students who arrive late to school will enter through the Welcome Center and will check-in through the Main Office. The student will then report directly to class.

If a student needs to leave school early, the parent should call the grade level office or the attendance secretary. The grade level office will send for the student at the time of his/her dismissal or the student may pick up the pass before school. The student will leave campus at the designated time or wait for his/her ride outside.

There will be no walk-in visitors (guest speakers, college recruiters, food delivery services, parents, family members, etc.) allowed on campus as a safety precaution.

Meals and Snacks

In-Person

Breakfast will be served from 8:00 – 8:28 am. All breakfast items will be grab-and-go with a wrapped dish for quick movement through the food serving stations.

Students will eat breakfast on the way to class or will eat quickly at an assigned table in the Commons. NO FOOD WILL BE ALLOWED IN CLASSROOMS.

Students will briefly remove their masks in order to take a bite and replace their masks while chewing. Students are encouraged to use straws for drinking.

Lunch will be served from 10:23 pm – 12:23 pm, in 4 lunch shifts. All lunch items will be grab-and-go with a wrapped dish for quick movement through the food stations. All items are provided to students at no cost until further notice. Students will grab their food from tables that are set up in different locations and head to their assigned table to eat lunch.

Please remember: Eating is a task! Students must replace their masks as soon as they are finished eating.

All available meals are as follows:

- Breakfast served from 8:00-8:28 in the cafeteria in a "Grab and Go" format
- "Grab and Sit" lunch served from 10:23-12:23 in the EHS Cafeteria

Bus Transportation

In-Person

The district has created plans to ensure a safe environment while getting to and from school. [Click here](#) to read the complete list of procedures. Some examples of these steps include

- Reducing the ridership in each bus significantly;
- Allowing the seat behind the driver to remain empty;
- Assigned seats for students; and
- Loading the bus in the same manner consistently.

The interior of the bus will be cleaned and disinfected twice daily, paying attention to high-touch surfaces, such as the entrance handrail, seats, steering wheel and door handles. The staff has been provided safety training on how to clean the bus effectively.

Buses will be using the district's [advanced level of protection](#) with a cleaning application that persistently and continuously protects surfaces for up to 90 days.

Increased circulation of outdoor air into the vehicle will be practiced to the extent possible.

Open food or drink containers will not be allowed on the bus. Student carry-on items (such as backpacks, sports bags, musical instruments, etc.) should be sanitized each morning before boarding the bus.

[Hand washing or use of hand sanitizer before boarding the bus is highly recommended.](#) Hand sanitizers have been installed on each bus.

There will be a late bus for our students who live in the city that departs EHS at 4:30.

An activity bus for students involved in athletics and activities is scheduled to leave EHS at 5:30 for the second semester. All students will be expected to leave campus after the dismissal of school unless they are participating in an approved extra-curricular activity and are meeting immediately with their adult sponsor. **THESE TIMES ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE.**

Classrooms

To see a complete list of the safety and sanitation procedures, [click here](#). The following steps will be taken to ensure a safe learning environment:

- We will remove unnecessary classroom furniture to create as much space as possible.
- Classrooms will have a spray bottle and a roll of paper towels for students/teachers to use throughout the day.
- Classrooms will be sanitized and disinfected three times a week.
- There will be no eating in classrooms.
- Masks will be REQUIRED while on campus: ABOVE THE NOSE and BELOW THE CHIN.
- Student seating will be spaced 3'-6' apart to the extent possible.
- Each classroom will have a sanitation station with sanitizer, tissue, and trashcan.

Cleaning

In-Person

- Additional custodial staff will be assigned to each school during the school day.
- There will be ongoing cleaning of high-touch surfaces throughout the building.
- Restrooms will be checked and cleaned three times throughout the day.
- Classrooms will be cleaned at the end of each school day and sanitized at a minimum of three times per week.
- The district will also be using a 90-day industrial sanitation spray in the EHS building.

In-Person:

Guardians will perform a daily health screening assessment for their children.

If a student develops a symptom at school, that student will alert the teacher before scanning a QR code for the nurse's office on the teacher's door and will wait for correspondence from the nurse's office by email on next steps. This will ensure the student's safety and the safety of others. When the student arrives at the health clinic, ring the doorbell and wait for the nurse to admit to the clinic.

Masks

In-Person

Based on guidance from local health officials, the following new procedures have been created to ensure the safety of our students. For a complete list of district guidelines regarding face coverings, [click here](#).

- All students will be required to wear face coverings at school. Wearing face masks limits the spread of illness, allowing students to be in school and helps keep our schools open. This will help meet our goal to provide maximum in-person learning and schedules in the traditional classroom.
- Students may move mask in order to take a bite and then replace mask while chewing.
- Meals are a task and not a social event.
- Students are encouraged to use a water bottle with a straw or bring a straw for their drink container to minimize the time that a students' mask is removed.
- **AT THIS TIME GAITORS AND BANDANAS ARE NOT ACCEPTED FACE COVERINGS.**
- Wearing of face coverings is consistent with guidance from the Centers for Disease Control (CDC), St. Louis County and the Missouri Department of Health for children ages two and older.
- Rockwood School District is committed to caring for all students and staff as part of our mission. We show care for others when we wear our mask at school. Wearing a mask helps protect our classmates and teachers/staff who are more at risk. Mask wearing allows everyone to participate in school.

EHS DRESS CODE
