

## Options for Senior Students:

All Students must enroll in 14 classes. If selected for one of these options, your counselors will meet with you to drop courses you do not need to take.

### Full Schedule

- Student elects to attend school at EHS all day every day.

### Senior Incentive

- Students who have earned at least 18 credits can apply
- Students can choose to leave early (after 6<sup>th</sup> hour) or to come in Late (start each day 2<sup>nd</sup> hour)
- Students must pass all classes the previous semester, have no fines, No discipline, and no unexcused absences
- Parent signature is required.
- Student should sign up for a study hall and the counselor will change the study hall to senior incentive when the student is approved.

### Tech School

- Attend EHS in the morning and Tech School in the afternoon
- Several Senior only programs

### CCE-Cooperative Career Education

- Must be accepted in order to be in this program. Application based
- Part-time school and part-time work for credits (10-19 hours or 20+ hours of work per week)
- May apply with or without a job.
- See Mr. Hunt in Room 703 for application or questions.

### Early Graduation/Early Release

- Students who have completed all graduation requirements by winter break (January 2021) have the option of graduating at semester.
- An Early Graduation form, which can be accessed in the guidance office, must be completed by the first day of school.

### A+ Program

- Students can take a study hall, community service, or cadet teaching to earn A+ Service hours.
- See Mr. Kirby in Testing to sign up for A+ Hours

### Dual Enrollment

- Students may enroll at EHS and WWCC concurrently.
- Must have a total of 6 classes to be a full-time student (2 at WWCC and 4 at EHS; 3 at WWCC and 3 at EHS, etc.)
- Student is still eligible to participate in all EHS activities and sports. (Must check eligibility with your counselor)
- Sign up for 14 classes on IC. When you meet with your counselor in February, you will receive the forms pertaining to dual enrollment.

Project Interface- Opportunity for students to earn CTE credit by applying various learned skills in a real-world situation.

- Application only
- You pick a session to complete: a) summer between Jr and Sr year; b) fall of senior year
- Must have a 3.0 GPA
